All attending Toronto Firefighters are reminded to wear their full-dress uniforms.

This will include:
White shirts, black ties, white gloves and issued headdress. Dress for the weather conditions.

The Celtic Society will be offering football scarves, green capes and a barbequed back bacon on a bun, with all proceeds going to charity. The Celtic Society and BBQ will be located on Grosvenor St. and they will be ready to serve you a hot sandwich after 9:30 am.

A shuttle will run from Adelaide Street Station 332 starting at 10:00 am until 11:30 am to the marshaling area. All Firefighters must form up by 11:50 am as the parade starts promptly at 12:00 noon.

At the end of the Parade, there will be a reception for all participating uniformed firefighters at Grace O'Malley's Pub, 14 Duncan St. (Just east of Stn. 332).
